


Barry is passionate about promoting everything that makes Candelo a wonderful place to live and is dedicated to helping the town remain a thriving, supportive, and welcoming community. T







INGREDIENTS

250G (8 OZ) SULTANAS
250G (8 OZ) CHOPPED RAISINS
250G (8 OZ) CURRANTS
125G (4 OZ) CHOPPED MIXED PEEL
90G (3 OZ) CHOPPED RED GLACE CHERRIES
90G (3 OZ) CHOPPED BLANCHED ALMONDS
½ CUP SHERRY OR BRANDY
250G (8 OZ) PLAIN FLOUR
60G (2 OZ) SELF RAISING FLOUR
¼ TEASPOON GRATED NUTMEG
½ TEASPOON GROUND CLOVES
½ TEASPOON GROUND GINGER
250G (8 OZ) BUTTER
250G (8 OZ) SOFT BROWN SUGAR
½ TEASPOON LEMON ESSENCE OR FINELY GRATED LEMON RIND
½ TEASPOON ALMOND ESSENCE
½ TEASPOON VANILLA ESSENCE
4 LARGE EGGS



METHOD

MIX TOGETHER ALL THE FRUITS AND NUTS AND SPRINKLE WITH THE SHERRY OR BRANDY. COVER AND LEAVE FOR AT LEAST 1 HOUR, BUT PREFERABLY OVERNIGHT.

SIFT TOGETHER THE FLOURS AND SPICES. CREAM TOGETHER THE BUTTER AND SUGAR WITH THE ESSENCES. ADD THE EGGS ONE AT A TIME, BEATING WELL AFTER EACH ADDITION, THEN ALTERNATELY ADD THE FRUIT AND FLOUR MIXTURES. MIX THOROUGHLY. THE MIXTURE SHOULD BE STIFF ENOUGH TO SUPPORT A WOODEN SPOON.

PLACE THE MIXTURE INTO A PREPARED TIN NO LARGER THAN 20 CM (8") AND BAKE IN A SLOW OVEN FOR APPROXIMATELY 3½ - 4 HOURS. ALLOW THE CAKE TO COOL IN THE TIN.
